

MONSOON PLANT CARE TIPS

01

Reduce Watering

With increased rainfall during the monsoon season, you may need to reduce the frequency of watering your plants. Overwatering can suffocate the roots.

02

Adequate Drainage

Ensure that your potted plants have proper drainage holes to prevent waterlogging. Place a layer of gravel or broken pottery at the bottom of the pot.



Trim away any dead or damaged branches, leaves, or flowers from your plants. Pruning helps improve air circulation & promotes healthy growth.

04

Avoid Overcrowding

Provide enough space between plants to allow proper airflow and reduce the risk of diseases. Plants placed too closely together can impede air circulation.

05

Provide Support

Heavy rainfall and strong winds can cause plants to bend or break. Use stakes or trellises to support taller plants and delicate branches.

Increase Nutrients

With increased rain, nutrients in the soil can get washed away. Consider supplementing your plants with organic fertilizers like vermicompost.

Watch for Pests

Monsoon brings an increase in pests like snails, slugs, and fungal gnats. Regularly inspect your plants for any signs of infestation.

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
